The latest you can request ballots is the close of the Town Clerk's office on <u>Thursday, March 24, 2022</u>. (Any other person authorized by you who is not a family member must apply in writing or in person for a ballot for you.) All ballots must be received by 7:00pm on March 28, 2022 in order to be counted.
